



## THE ASSOCIATION

Maine Municipal Association is a voluntary membership organization offering professional services to municipalities and other local governmental entities. MMA is a non-profit, nonpartisan organization governed by an Executive Board elected from its member municipalities.

Founded in 1937, MMA is one of 49 similar state municipal leagues that are recognized at all levels for providing valuable services and advocating for collective municipal interests.

MMA publishes and updates numerous periodicals, manuals, special reports, directories, etc., dealing with various aspects of Maine local government and municipal officials' duties and responsibilities. MMA also has a Website with an Extranet (password protected area) available to members.

MMA sponsors an annual convention in October, and also conducts many special training and certification courses for municipal officials who want to sharpen their professional skills throughout the year.

There are three categories of MMA Patron — open to citizens, students, professionals, and businesses that have an interest in local government. MMA by-laws acknowledge and define the three types of MMA Patron. Each category of MMA Patron provides different levels of access to MMA's informational and educational programming.

## TYPES OF PATRON

**Individual Patron** — intended to include interested citizens, former municipal officials, college professors, and students of government. The annual fee for this Patron category is \$75.00 per person. The services provided to Individual Patrons are as follows:

- ✘ One subscription to the Maine Townsman, the official monthly magazine of MMA.
- ✘ One subscription to the MMA Legislative Bulletin, published weekly during sessions of the Maine State Legislature, and at various times throughout the year.
- ✘ One Municipal Officials Directory (published annually).

✘ Other MMA publications can be purchased at member rates. An MMA Publications List will be sent to you when you join.

✘ Attendance at MMA meetings and training programs at the same registration fee as municipal officials.

**Professional Patron** — intended to include those individuals who have a business interest or professional relationship with municipal government, including municipal attorneys, engineers, accountants, consultants, and professional trainers. Individuals representing private businesses are also eligible for this Patron category. The annual fee for this Patron category is \$200.00 per person. The services provided to Professional Patrons are as follows:

- ✘ One subscription to the Maine Townsman, the official monthly magazine of MMA.
- ✘ One subscription to the MMA Legislative Bulletin, published weekly during sessions of the Maine State Legislature, and at various times throughout the year.
- ✘ One Municipal Officials Directory (published annually).
- ✘ Other MMA publications can be purchased at member rates. An MMA Publications List will be sent to you when you join.
- ✘ Attendance at MMA meetings and training programs at the same registration fee as municipal officials.
- ✘ Access to the password protected area of MMA's website.

**Business Patron** — intended to include organizations, companies or businesses that have a business interest or professional relationship with municipal government. The annual fee for this Patron category is \$500.00 per company/organization. The services provided to Business Patrons are as follows:

- ✘ Two subscriptions to the Maine Townsman, the official monthly magazine of MMA.
- ✘ Two subscriptions to the MMA Legislative Bulletin, published weekly during sessions of the Maine State Legislature, and at various times throughout the year.
- ✘ Two Municipal Officials Directories (published annually).



- Other MMA publications can be purchased at member rates. An MMA Publications List will be sent to you when you join.
- Attendance at MMA meetings and training programs at the same registration fee as municipal officials.
- Multiple access to the password protected area of MMA's website for up to five people.
- A listing in the Annual Convention program as a supporting member of the Maine Municipal Association.

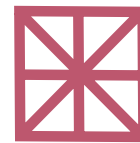
**AN MMA PATRON IS NOT...**
