Position Established via Poll & Zoom Meetings

Once members have had the opportunity to remove items, what remains on the list will be adopted in a single motion and then the chair will open the discussion on the removed bills and call for a motion for each bill.

There are two bills that staff have removed from the consent agenda because the polling results were inconclusive and require additional LPC feedback.
