MMA's Legislative Policy Committee April 16, 2025 Supplemental Agenda

- I. LPC Meeting for May. Staff have decided that the May 22 meeting date would be too late for their purposes and have cancelled that meeting date in favor of a Zoom-only meeting earlier in the month, on Wednesday, May 14. There may also be the need for surveys and impromptu Zoom meetings between now and the end of the legislative session.
- II. Updated Items on original Notice & Agenda. One of the bills on the original agenda under Housing & Economic Development, LD 1232, An Act to Require Radon Testing for Certain Commercial and Residential Construction, has been amended by the sponsor. There has also been a review by MMA's Legal Services Department of another bill on the original agenda under Veterans & Legal Affairs, LD 1365, An Act to Allow Consumption of Adult Use Cannabis in Locally Approved Hospitality Lounges, which can be found at <u>Attachment S-2</u>.
