## Supplemental Agenda

The following amendments to bills of municipal interest have been moved into the hopper since the distribution of the agenda for Thursday's LPC meeting. Summary descriptions of these amendments have been provided as **Attachment #S-1**.

**I. Proposed legislation.** A summary description of each bill subject to LPC review is provided in MMA's "LD List 2019" (**Attachment #S-1**).

a. Agriculture, Conservation & Forestry-related legislation.

1. LD 1518 – An Act To Establish a Fund for Portions of the Operations and Outreach Activities of the University of Maine Cooperative Extension Diagnostic and Research Laboratory and To Increase Statewide Enforcement of Pesticide Use.
2. LD 1561 – An Act To Amend the Maine Land Use Planning Commission Laws and Enhance the Economic Vitality of of Neighboring Communities.

b. Labor & Housing-related legislation.

1. LD 1620 – An Act To Exclude Collectively Bargained Salary and Job Promotion Increases from the Earnable Compensation Limitation for Retirement Purposes.

c. State & Local Government-related legislation.

1. LD 1476 *amendment* – An Act To Clarify Recounts in Municipal Elections.

d. Transportation-related legislation.

1. LD 1627 – An Act To Authorize the Use of Autocycles.

e. Veterans & Legal Affairs-related legislation.

1. LD 1619 – An Act Regarding Licenses for the Sale of Liquor for On-premises Consumption.
2. LD 1621 – An Act To Allow Delivery of Adult Use Marijuana and Adult Use Marijuana Products by an Approved Marijuana Store.
3. LD 1631 – RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine Concerning Early Voting, Voting by Absentee Ballot and Voting by Mail.
